ABOUT NEVIS BLUFF & THE CENTRAL OTAGO REGION

One of the original pioneers in Central Otago, Nevis Bluff has been producing premium wines since 1998.

Nevis Bluff channels the spirit of the pioneering gold prospectors who carved their fortunes from Central Otago's rugged landscape. Winemaker Matt Connell crafts wines of precision and depth – each bottle a reflection of this region's wild beauty and enduring legacy.

Once known for gold-mining in the 1800's the new "rush" of Central Otago is for Pinot Noir. At altitude 45 Degree S, this is the southernmost wine producing region in the world. Sheltered by mountains, this inland area is New Zealand's only wine region that has a continental climate rather than maritime.

The hot, dry summers are followed by short, cool autumns and cold winters. Early-ripening Pinot Noir thrives in the steep and rocky terrain, achieving perfect ripeness in the sunny summer days while retaining its characteristic crisp acidity during the cool evenings.

COLOUR = Ruby red.

BOUQUET = Boldly aromatic, this Pinot Noir exhibits a classic Otago flavours of dark cherry and blackberry fruit offset with spice and floral notes.

PALATE = The palate has the region's signature plushness and silky elegance, with fine tannins and a long, persistent finish.

FOOD MATCH = Goes well with beef stroganoff or pasta with ragu.

CELLARING POTENTIAL = With careful cellaring the wine will last up to 5 years.

2024 The Bluff Pinot Noir 14.0% Alc

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COLOUR = Bright Ruby

BOUQUET = Captivates the senses with a complex interplay between notes of mocha, dark fruit and dried herbs.

PALATE = Exquisitely layered and rich, offering tantalizing hints of Doris plum, red cherry, and bramble characters. Supported by fine tannins and a long, luxurious finish, every sip is a celebration of exceptional craftsmanship.

FOOD MATCH = Great wine to be accompanied by veal and other red meat dishes as well as paired to a brie cheese afterwards.

CELLARING POTENTIAL = With careful cellaring the wine will last up to 10 + years.

2024 Single Vineyard Pinot Noir 14.0% Alc

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COLOUR = Dark violet.

BOUQUET = Dark berry, tapenade, cured meat, dried mushroom, and elegant oak characters on the nose.

PALATE = Complex and seductive, elegant oak characters on the nose, leading to a concentrated palate offering excellent depth and expansive mouthfeel. The wine combined power and grace with a sustained, alluring finish.

FOOD MATCH = Pairs well with duck breast with cherry glaze or lamb rack with rosemary and garlic.

CELLARING POTENTIAL = With careful cellaring the wine will last up to 10 + years.
